Drawing/Teacher Workshops

Residency offered:

Part One

Drawing classes for grades 3-6

Classes run 1-1 1/2 hours, as time permits. One normal class in size(around 25 students)

Up to four classes per day can be taught and up to five days per residency

1. Using layout to find proportion and plan a composition
 2. Finish a 'line drawing' by cleaning up layout lines, refining and adding missing details
 3. Move to advanced techniques of shading, highlighting and adding texture
- * Demonstrations of drawing techniques by actual artist and star of video series
"Easy2Draw with Cordi"*

Materials: vine charcoal, charcoal pencils, white charcoal pencils, blending stumps, erasers, small pieces of sand paper and paper.

Part Two

2 copies each of the three DVDs (or VHS if desired) in the **Easy2Draw series** will be left with the **school library**. They add up to 4 hours of self-guided drawing instruction to be used individually or in a class situation.

In addition 1 or 2 **workshop classes** will be offered **to teachers** to help give ideas and inspiration on teaching art to children. The workshops will be hands-on and 2 hours long. They can be offered in evenings, after school or on a Saturday morning. Highly recommended for teachers who feel unable to do art well themselves and may feel at a loss when teaching children. It will be a lot of fun!

I can teach the children in their normal classrooms but for the teacher's workshop it would be nice to have a sink and tables to work on if possible. After 22 years of 'art on a cart', I can work with the situation on hand!

Experience:

I am best known for public sculpture and have an award winning municipal piece in front of the library in Puyallup, another sculpture in front of the library in Leavenworth and have participated in numerous outdoor sculpture shows around Washington State. I have worked as a professional window painter for over 30 years, painting for rodeos, holidays and festivals.
